Transportation Procedures

- Passengers are to use hand sanitation/wipes and to wipe down hands prior to entering the bus.
- Alberni Island Shuttle drivers will provide hand sanitizer/ wipes to passengers. Waste disposal will be made available on the bus.
- No food or drink will be permitted on the buses.
- Passengers are reminded to avoid touching their face and limit touching other areas of the bus to help reduce the risks of contamination to themselves or others.
- Passengers are recommended to follow the updated recommendations of our Provincial Health Officer in British Columbia while utilizing our transportation.
- Drivers will comply with the updated information following the instructions of our Provincial Health Officer for Covid19. http://covid-19.bccdc.ca/
- Passengers are to supply their own personal protection items in the event they become ill in their travels.
- Alberni Island Shuttle will sanitize the bus after each group has exited with a
 focus on points of higher hand contact such as handrails, seatbelts, armrests,
 steering wheel, luggage door handle, etc., to reduce risks of cross
 contamination. Gloves and cleaning supplies will be available on each bus.
- Passengers that refuse to follow our Covid19 Prevention Procedures will be not permitted to travel on the bus in our workplace.
